CALL FOR GENERAL USER PROPOSALS: DUE July 15, 2007

The Users' Services Office at the Advanced Light Source is accepting general user proposals from scientists who wish to conduct research in the general sciences at the ALS during the January - June 2008 running cycle. The deadline for submissions is July 15, 2007. (This deadline does not apply to protein crystallography proposals, which have a separate process and schedule.) To submit a new proposal, please complete the form, "ALS General User Proposal and Request for Beamtime:

If you have an existing proposal for which you would like to request beam time during the January - June 2008 cycle, please submit a Proposal Renewal Form: http://alsusweb.lbl.gov/4DCGI/WEB_GetForm/RolloverPassword.shtml/Initialize.

Proposals may be renewed for up to three, six-month cycles after the initial submission. After a total of four cycles, a new proposal must be submitted.
