# PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

## **MUST (always):**

- Closed Toe Shoes (no Sandals or Flip-Flops) and Long Pants
- Safety Glasses with Side Shields or Safety Goggles
- No Food or Drinks inside the Lab (leave in PRIME: 2-108)
- Appropriate Gloves when handling Chemicals incl. Solvents (for help: consult MSDS)

## **WHEN APPROPRIATE (depending on the task):**

- Lab Coat and long Pants when handling Chemicals
- Steel Toe Shoes and sturdy Gloves when lifting heavy & rough Objects with a Crane
- Safety Glasses with Side Shields (<1bar) or Face Shield (>1bar) and appropriate Gloves and long Pants when handling liquid Nitrogen
- Use a Fan when soldering (beware of hazardous Fumes) & wash Hands after completing lead work

## **OPTIONAL (highly recommended):**

- Make Use of Ear Protection when applicable (Plugs or Muffs provided inside)
- Confine long Hair (put it up, have Pony Tail etc.)
- Speak English (prevent Misunderstandings and Exclusion of People)

• Use Safety Equipment when appropriate	gloves, earplugs, lab coat, fan, hard hat, goggles, face shield, signal tapes & signs...
• Do not block Doors, Aisles or elec. Panels	think of an earthquake or fire or power loss...
